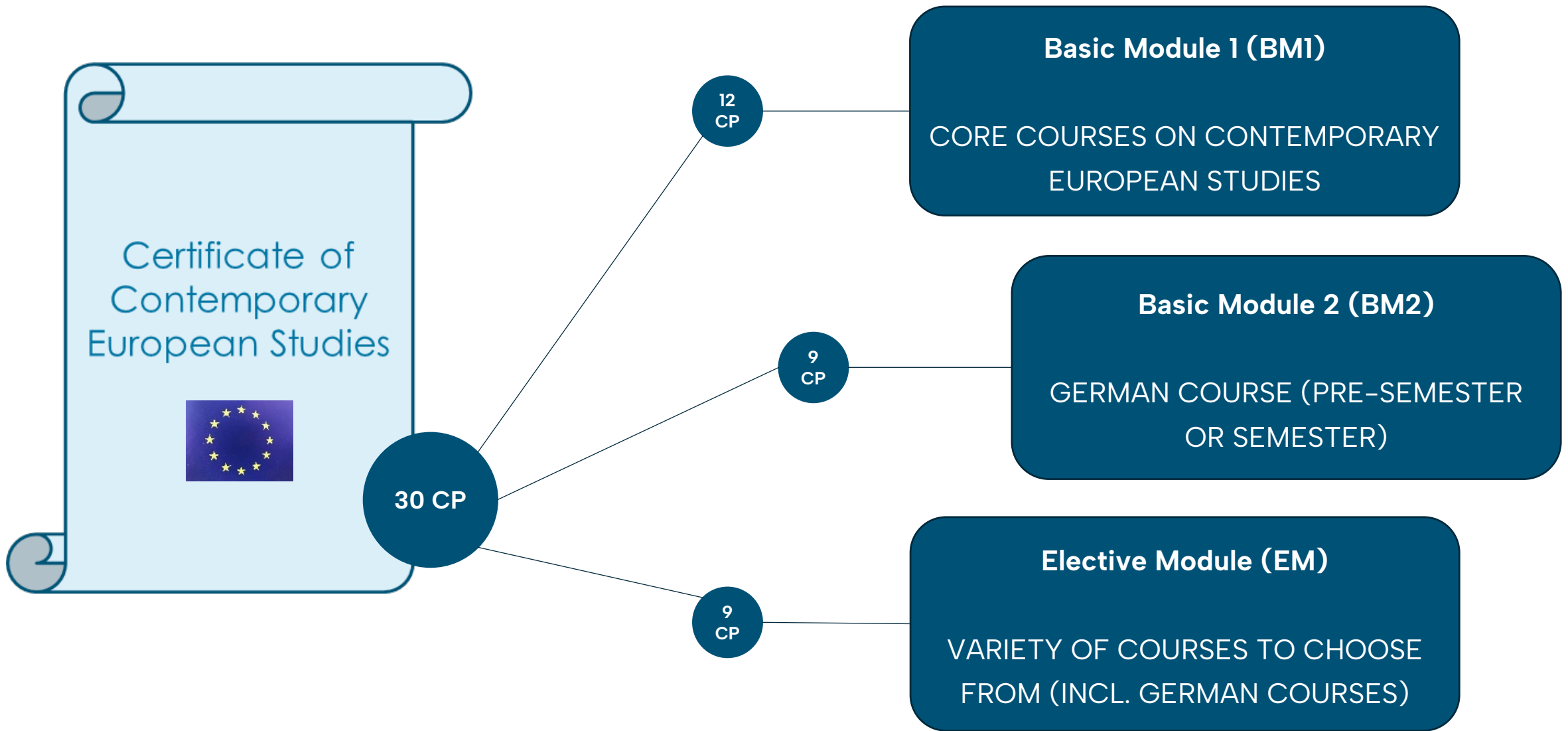

- each course is counting 3CP, the combined final module exam for those three courses will count another 3CP

you need to choose one course per thematic field

- one purple colored (history or culture)
- one orange colored (economy or society)
- one green colored (politics or law)

all core courses are on introductory level – no previous knowledge required

BASIC MODULE 2 AND ELECTIVE MODULE COURSES

BM2

- German courses will be registered on Klips through the German department directly – follow registering instructions passed via email
- German courses will appear on Klips, but delayed

EM

- German courses to be counted for the EM do not need to be registered for on Klips (procedure is the same as for BM2)
- faculty courses – register via Klips
- core courses – register via Klips
- you will need a total of (at least) 9cp for the elective module

NOTE:

CGSP students are entitled to *two German courses per semester*. If you want to continue with the semester course after the pre-semester course, make sure to inform us before the end of the pre-semester course.

The pre-semester course would count towards the BM2, the additional semester course would count towards the EM.

KLIPS 2.0

- Klips 2.0 is the campus management system of the UoC
- you need to have activated your student account (Klips access is equivalent to your student mail account information)
- you have access to Klips with your private mailing adress → applicant status, limited functions!
- you need student status (log-in with your smail user name) in order to register for courses!
- course registration is possible during the so-called registration-phases (announced on our website)


